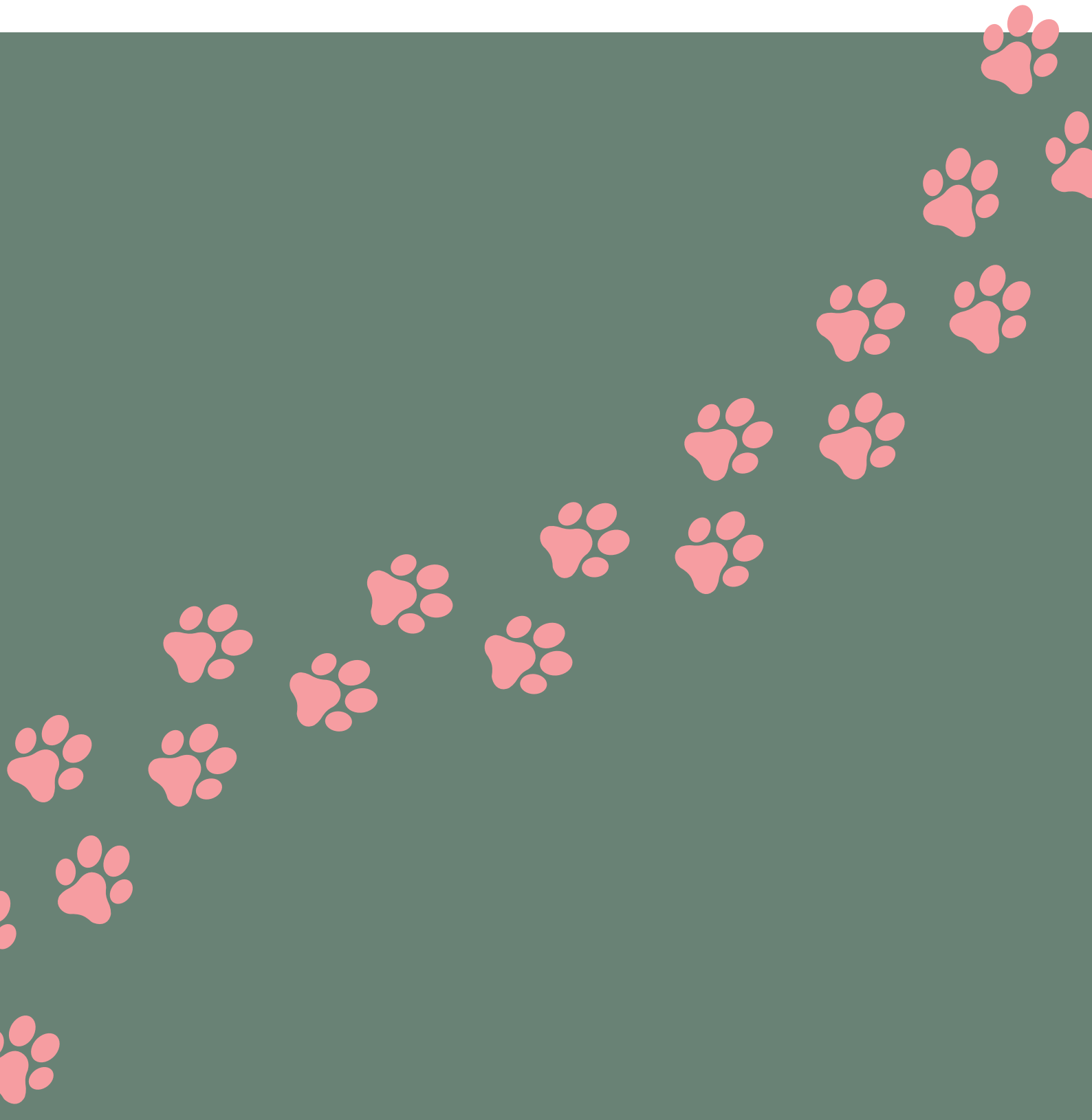

# REPORT OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS

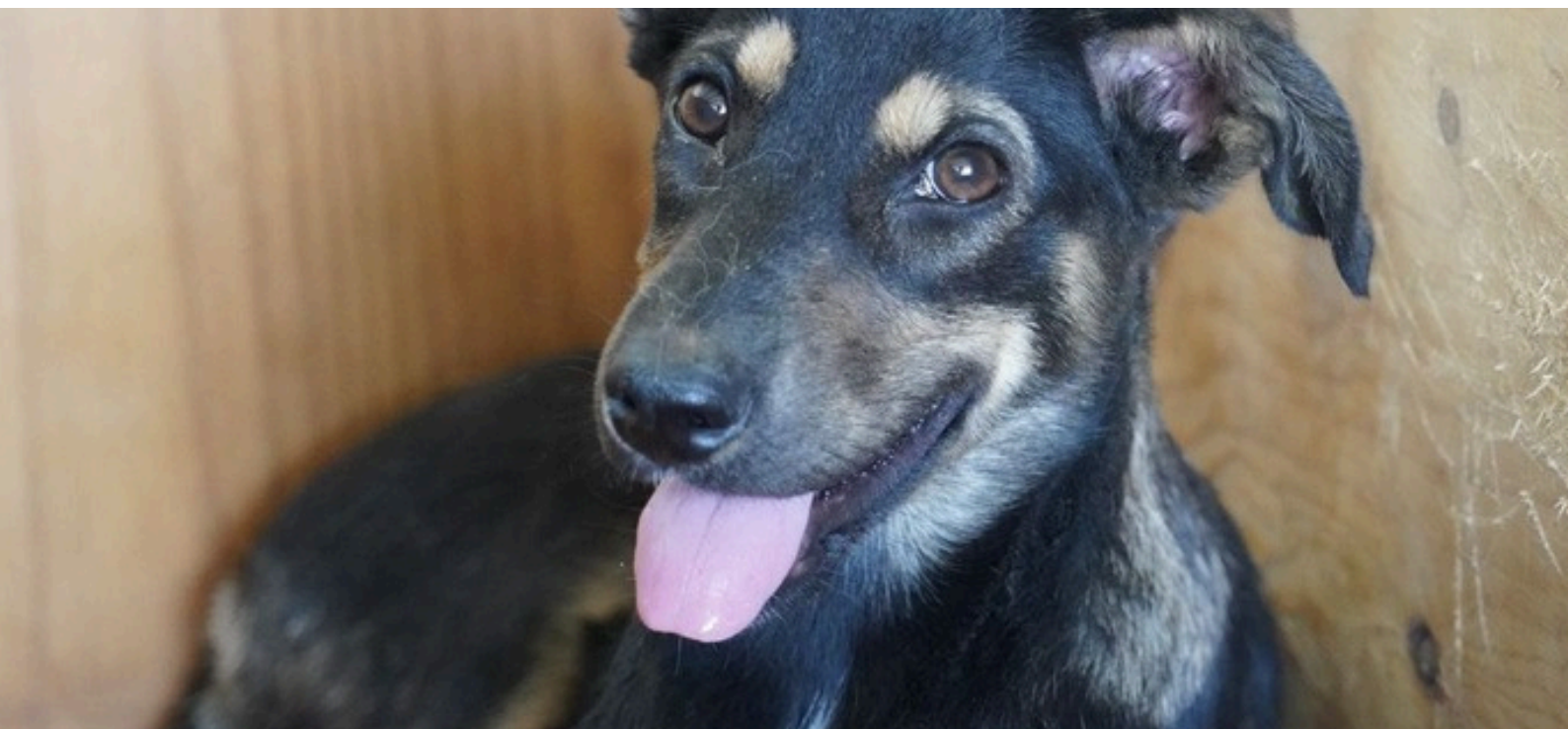
Despite the challenging situation in Europe and the daily obstacles we continue to face, our dedicated team achieved extraordinary results in 2025. We would like to express our deepest gratitude, especially to:

- Alice, our veterinarian and shelter manager
- Eugen, our dog whisperer
- Doru and Lilly, our caring animal caretaker couple
- Geta and Andreea, our dedicated animal caretakers
- Viorel, our maintenance manager
- Dan, our newest team member, whose veterinary training and practical skills make him a perfect addition to our team
- Bogdan, our veterinarian, who, together with an outstanding team of veterinarians, conducts spay and neuter campaigns in rural communities on weekends

Together with this remarkable team, we currently support five additional shelters facing financial hardship and help care for more than 1,000 dogs and 120 cats.

Every month, approximately 5.5 tonnes of food are distributed. By organizing surplus food donations from supermarkets and securing sponsored dog food from restaurants and other partners, our team manages to provide efficient and responsible care for the animals.

This is an extraordinary achievement that deserves the highest respect and recognition.





## **Achievements in 2025**

Despite challenging economic and political conditions, we were able to achieve significant successes in 2025 thanks to your support:

### **455 Animals Found Loving Homes**

A total of 455 animals were able to move into loving forever homes in Germany, France, the Netherlands, Romania, Belgium, Luxembourg, and Switzerland.

### **471 Animals Rescued**

We rescued 471 animals during the year, including a particularly high number of vulnerable puppies who urgently needed our help and protection.

### **517 Spay and Neuter Procedures**

Thanks to the tireless dedication of Alice and her team, 517 dogs and cats were spayed or neutered through large-scale sterilization campaigns, support for private shelters, and our free “Spay & Neuter Tuesday” program at The Dog Rose Shelter.

## **Gratitude for Our Partnerships**

We are deeply grateful for the trusting cooperation with our partner animal welfare organizations across Europe. Through their ongoing support and collaboration, our animals are able to find safe, loving homes beyond national borders and are given the opportunity for a brighter future.

### **International Volunteers and Community**

Another highlight of the year was the visit of international volunteers and local school classes to our shelter. Together, we completed renovation projects, learned from one another, and shared meaningful experiences that will leave a lasting impact on everyone involved.

### **The Team – Unity and Vision**

The year 2025 has brought our team even closer together. We have become like a family, standing side by side through both challenges and successes. Our mission remains clear: with compassion, responsibility, and unwavering dedication, we help animals in need while also supporting socially disadvantaged children. ## FINANCIAL REPORT

Despite ongoing challenging conditions and rising prices for medical care, infrastructure, and food, we were able to achieve a positive annual result of CHF 107,634.81 in 2025 thanks to the continued support of loyal donors, patrons, and supporters.

The Dog Rose generates only limited income within Romania itself, primarily through adoption fees from placements in the EU and a few boarding contributions from foster care placements at the shelter.

Thanks to a generous donor, we saw our income grow to CHF 294,340.25 — an increase over the previous year. Fortunately, our expenses have decreased to CHF 186,705.44, due to good cost management and a lower number of spayings.

This year, we did not carry out major renovation work at the shelter, which resulted in a noticeable reduction in costs compared to the prior year.

Additionally, all adoption-related transport costs and mailing costs were covered through sponsorships, which further helped reduce our expenditures.

The calendar year 2025 therefore closed with a surplus of CHF 107,634.81.

### **Income and Cost Structure**

Sponsorships and individual donations remain the backbone of our funding. Income from adoptions totaled CHF 22,813.00.



### **Decrease Compared to Previous Year**

We were able to report a decrease of CHF 3,000 in adoption fees compared to the previous year. The remarkable commitment of our loyal donors and patrons has remained steady. Thank you! Expenses for sterilizations, medical care, and shelter maintenance totaled CHF 186,705.44.

Through targeted measures, we optimized costs and strengthened our impact.

### **Association Assets as of December 31, 2025 including Proposal for Allocation of 2024 Surplus**

The board proposes to the annual general assembly that the 2025 surplus of CHF 107,634.81 be allocated to the association's assets. Following approval of this proposal by the assembly, the association's assets as of December 31, 2025, will amount to CHF 165,011.83, compared to CHF 57,377.02 at the end of 2024.

Fortunately, the supporting association Citydogs4Streetdogs, which funds The Dog Rose, has built a solid financial foundation over the past years. However, we can no longer absorb additional losses — we urgently rely on your continued generous support.

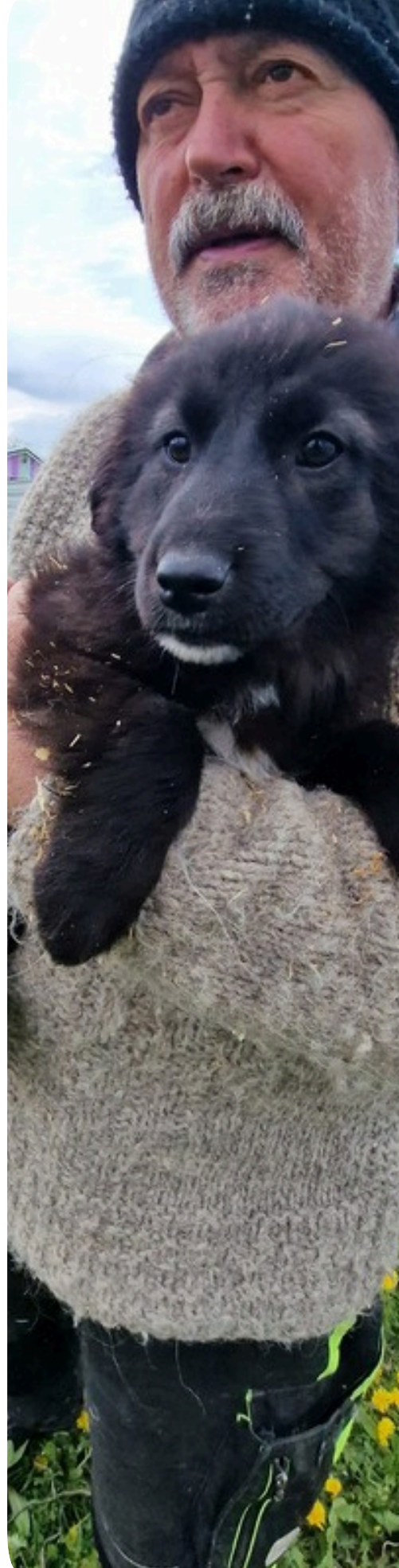
